White Elephant by Julie Langsdorf

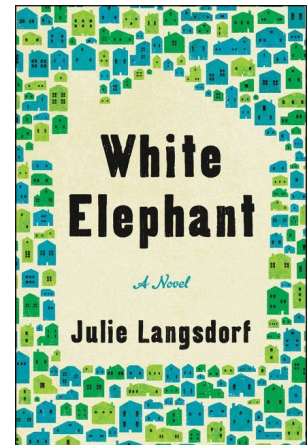
Humorous suburban drama, similar to Ann Patchett and Meg Wolitzer

Cleaning tips to keep your home healthy, organized, and clean

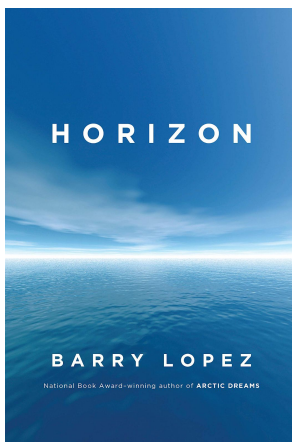
