A dark psychological thriller focused on the impact of an abusive and traumatic childhood on six siblings later in their lives – similar to *Room* and *Sharp Objects*

#### ***The Echo Wife* by Sarah Gailey (2/16)**

A character-driven, near-future suspense novel about a scientist who discovers her husband is having an affair with her clone... you haven't read a domestic thriller like this!

#### ***The Witch's Heart* by Genevieve Gornichec (2/9)**

A retelling of a Norse legend from a new perspective – for those who enjoyed Madeline Miller's *Circe* and Neil Gaiman's *Norse Mythology*

#### ***The Four Winds* by Kristin Hannah (L, 2/2)**

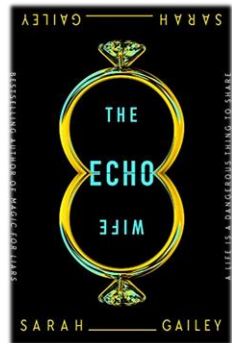
An intimate depiction of a mother's experiences through the Dust Bowl and the Depression

An archaeological mystery set in New Mexico with strong female characters – the second in the Nora Kelly series



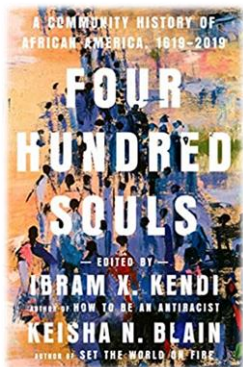
### Nonfiction:
