The Sacrament by Olaf Olafsson

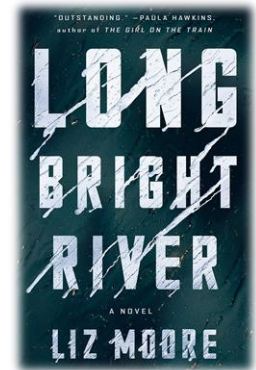
An affecting, character-driven thriller focused on a nun haunted by her memories
