Bearskin by James A. McLaughlin

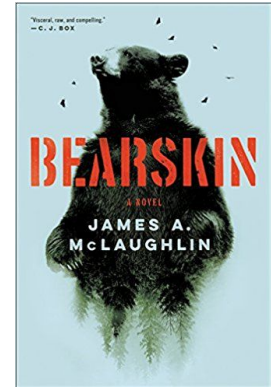
A haunting thriller set in a forest preserve where bears are being killed... oh my!
