***If She Wakes* by Michael Koryta**

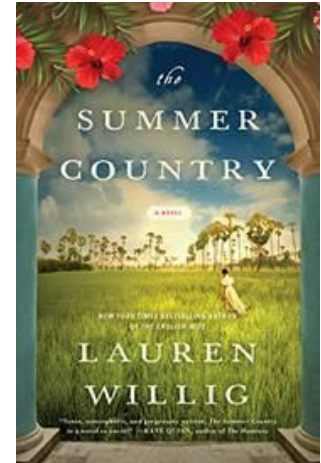
A suspenseful whodunit that begins with a suspicious car accident
