The Reckoning by John Grisham (SR, LP)

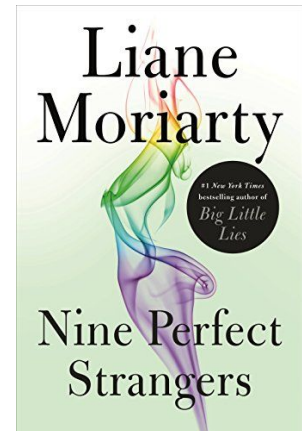
Grisham returns with a legal thriller set in the fictional town of Clanton, MS

A Spark of Light by Jodi Picoult (SR, AB)

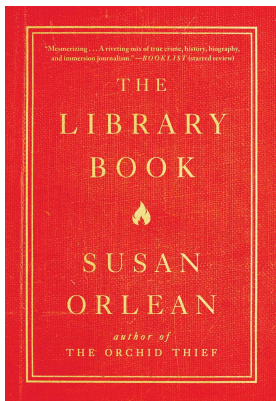
The always-popular author returns with a story about a hostage situation at a women's reproductive health clinic
