#### ***Akin* by Emma Donoghue**

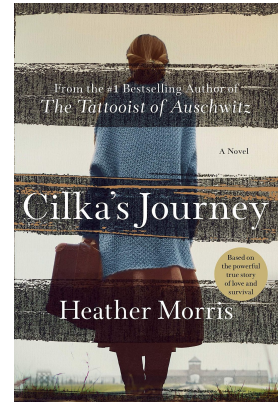
A character-driven family novel -- for those interested in World War II
