#### ***When These Mountains Burn* by David Joy**

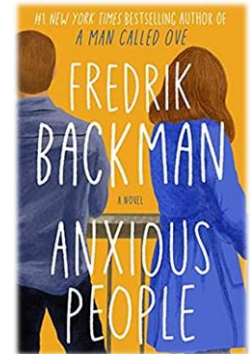
A mystery focused on the impact of addiction and the drug trade on a father and his son
